1. Counsel for the petitioners states that in order to show their bonafide, the petitioners have brought a demand draft of Rs.5 lakhs against the outstanding amount. A xerox copy of the same has been placed on record.

2. Mr. Saurabh Bhardwaj, Advocate, who is appearing through virtual platform and representing respondent No.3 – Bank states that total amount due is more than Rs.25 lakhs. He, however, has instructions to state that in case the petitioners come forward and submit a proposal for One Time Settlement (OTS), the same shall be duly considered by the respondent-Bank. Counsel further states that previously, e-auction was fixed on 06.05.2026 by the Debts Recovery Tribunal, but it failed and fresh auction has not been fixed so far.
