KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(ORAL)

1. Through the instant writ petition, cast under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for quashing of award dated 28.01.2008 (Annexure P-1), wherethrough, the reference was answered in favour of the respondent No.1/workman, and he was awarded the relief of reinstatement on his previous post with continuity of service and 50% back wages.

2. During the pendency of the instant writ petition, the respondent No.1/workman, was reinstated into the service, and now the only issue, which remains adjudication is with regard to back wages.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions imparted to him from the quarter concerned, submits that in case, the respondent No.1/workman, waive off his right with regard to back wages, the

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petitioner/Management, would not press the instant writ petition, with regard to legality of reinstatement, as awarded by learned Tribunal.

4. In view of the consensus arrived at between the parties, the impugned award is modified to the extent that respondent No.1/workman, is entitled to reinstatement on his previous post with continuity of service. However, without any back wages.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for respondent No.1/workman, submits that his case be considered for regularization.

6. This Court is of the considered opinion that the above said aspect cannot be adjudicated through the instant writ petition, and for the said purpose, the respondent No.1/workman, is at liberty to approach the authorities concerned, to establish his right of regularization.

7. Consequently, the instant writ petition is **disposed of being not pressed.**
