Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing respondent No.2-learned Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Dera Bassi, District S.A.S. Nagar, to pass a final order in furtherance to the conditional order dated 16.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) passed under the provisions of Section 152(1)(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023.

2. Today, learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.6 have informed the Court that in fact the conditional order dated 16.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) has already been complied with at the spot and the obstructions at the site have already been removed.

3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner has also not disputed the aforesaid fact that the obstructions at the site have been



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removed and the conditional order dated 16.09.2025 (Annexure P-3) has been complied with. However, he submits that the private respondents in order to harass the petitioner are again resorting to throwing of garbage etc. at the site.

4. The aforesaid stand taken by learned counsel for the petitioner is disputed by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.6, however, they submit that in case any such re-occurrence happens, the petitioner can submit an appropriate application to the concerned municipal authorities and they assure that in such eventuality, prompt action would be taken.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.6, no further order is required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is disposed of accordingly.

6. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
