Petitioner-Sunil Kumar @ Silli, aged 24 years, has filed the instant petition under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 seeking regular bail in case FIR No.353 dated 11.11.2025 under Sections 109, 115, 117(2), 324, 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Sadar Pehowa, District Kurukshetra.

2. Incident in question took place on 09.11.2024 at about 7:00 PM and total three accused were named i.e. Manish, Abhishek and three unknown persons.

As per allegations, when accused persons were quarrelling with a handcart puller (Rehadi Wala) on phone, at Bus Stand Ishaq, complainant-Khushwant Singh suggested them not to fight for humanity. However, accused-Manish abused the complainant and threatened to see him in future. After sometime, both the named accused along with three other companions



armed with *Binde and Rod*, came and by pulling out the complainant from his medical shop (Dandayan Medical Store), the assailants again started abusing and then caused injuries to him with the weapons with which they were armed and also snatched an amount of Rs.40,000/- from his pocket and gold ring from his finger and one chain from the neck. As per medico-legal examination of complainant, out of 06 injuries, he has suffered 04 grievous injuries. The eyewitness as well as injured Khushwant Singh are yet to be examined.

3. In view of the above, the instant petition is disposed of with the observation that after examination of the material witnesses and passing of a reasonable period of incarceration inside the jail, petitioner may file a fresh petition for bail.

4. Trial Court is directed to record statements of material witnesses without much delay. Copy of this order be forwarded to the trial Court for information and compliance.
