1. This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner along with protection of the petitioner's property and for setting aside order dated 06.09.2025 (Annexure P-9) passed by the Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, whereby the representation submitted by the petitioner has been rejected allegedly without due consideration of the mandate of law. It is also prayed for issuance of appropriate directions for entrustment of investigation in FIR No.0273 dated 26.10.2016 under Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, and Sections 147, 148, 149, 285, 427 and 447 IPC, 1860 [corresponding to Sections 191(2), 191(3), 190, 287, 324(4) and 329(3) of the BNS, 2023], at Police Station Sirsa

Sadar, District Sirsa (Annexure P-1), to some independent agency such as the Crime Branch or by constituting a Special Investigating Team (SIT) and to take action against the culprits accordingly.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the aforesaid FIR was registered by the petitioner against the private respondents way back in the year 2016, however, despite lapse of substantial time, no effective progress has been made in the matter.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Rakesh Kumar Jangra, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and upon instructions, submits that the cancellation report has been prepared and the same shall be presented before the competent Court/authority within a period of four weeks.

5. In view of the submission of learned State counsel, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the official respondents to ensure that the cancellation report be presented before the competent Court/authority within a period of four weeks from now.

6. In case the petitioner still has any grievance, he shall be at liberty to approach the concerned competent Court/authority in accordance with law.

7. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
