1. The present writ petition under Section 528 of the BNSS, 2023 has been filed seeking directions to the official respondents to take appropriate and expeditious action on the complaint/representation dated 18.03.2026 (Annexure P-8) submitted by the petitioners. The petitioners further pray for registration of an FIR and initiation of a fair and proper investigation against the private respondents for alleged commission of cognizable offences, including illegal demolition. The petitioners also seek protection of their life and liberty, as they are stated to be under threat and harassment at the hands of the private respondents.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that for redressal of their grievance, the petitioners have already filed a complaint/representation dated 18.03.2026 (Annexure P-8) before the Senior

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Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, however no action has been taken on the same till date.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sahil Chowdhary, AAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the case and in view of the submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to decide the representation dated 18.03.2026 (Annexure P-8) filed by the petitioners, qua threat perception in accordance with law within a period of one month from today and grant immediate protection, if any threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, is perceived.

6. It is being clarified that this order shall not be taken to grant immunity to the petitioners for legal action for violation of law, if any, committed by them.

7. Pending application(s), if any, is/are disposed of.
