1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant arrears of pay after granting Ist, 2nd and 3rd ACP scales, as admissible from time to time alongwith Mewat Areas Allowances and consider the claim of the petitioner for commutation of pension with a further prayer to grant interest @ 18 % on the delayed payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to the respondent/State to decide the demand notice dated 03.02.2026 (Annexure P-8).

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, DAG Haryana, having served with an advance copy of the petition, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent/State



and assures the Court that the above-said demand notice will be decided within time bound manner.

5. Without adverting to the merits of the case, the respondents/Competent Authority, is directed to decide the Demand notice dated 03.02.2026 (Annexure P-8), within a period of 8 weeks from today, after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner. A copy of speaking order so passed will be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.

6. The petition in the aforesaid terms stands disposed off.
