The instant first petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.09 dated 15.01.2026 registered under Sections 309(4), 317(2), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

2. Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the case of the petitioner would be very similar to the case of the co-accused Roop Chand to whom regular bail has been granted by this Court vide order dated 27.04.2026 passed in CRM-M-21765-2026.

3. Learned State Counsel does not dispute the abovementioned contention of the petitioner.

4. I have heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respective parties.

5. In view of the facts noticed above and taking into consideration that co-accused Roop Chand has already been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 27.04.2026 passed in CRM-M-21765-2026, thus with a view to extend parity and keeping the case of the present



petitioner at par with the co-accused, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

6. The instant petition is ***allowed*** and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

7. It is made clear that the petitioner shall not extend any threat and shall not influence any prosecution witnesses in any manner directly or indirectly.

8. The observation made hereinabove shall not be construed as an expression on the merits of the case and the Trial Court shall decide the case on the basis of available material.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
