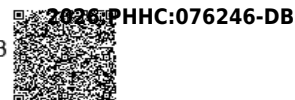
SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Mr. Bali, learned senior counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has approached this Court, *inter-alia*, seeking two-fold reliefs. He submits that petitioner is seeking quashing of restoration order dated 24.03.2026, Annexure P-26, issued under Section 12(2) of the Haryana Scheduled Roads and Controlled Areas Restriction of Unregulated Development Act, 1963 (for short "the 1963 Act"). He states that petitioner has a remedy of filing an appeal before the Tribunal under Section 12-C(3) of the 1963 Act, which shall be done within a fortnight from today.

2. In so far as the second relief is concerned, Mr. Bali submits that petitioner is entitled to get the land use changed and he has submitted an application, which is being considered by the respondents. He states that some



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objections were raised by the respondents, which were removed and application was re-submitted on 28.04.2026. He has requested that the respondents-authorities be directed to take a final decision on the application expeditiously.

3. Advance copy of the petition has been served upon the respondents.
4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana puts in appearance on their behalf. He has instructions to State that a final decision shall be taken within a period of 60 days from the date of re-submission of the application as per the relevant rules.
5. In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of.
