The instant petition has been filed by the petitioners for directions to the official respondents to transfer the investigation pertaining to a case arising out of FIR No.142 dated 20.12.2025, under Sections 21, 27(a) and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, Police Station Khichian, Amritsar (Rural).

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the petitioners have filed the representation (Annexure P-3) before the respondent No.3. The learned counsel prays for directions to the respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioners within the stipulated time.

4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State. Hence service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.3 to decide the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of representation. The respondent No.3 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of letter of the petitioner, and take an independent decision at his own level.
