This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) and regularized to the petitioner on the post of Sweeper and release the all consequential benefits to the petitioner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied, in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) within a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Deepak Balyan, Addl. A.G., Haryana having been served with an advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and assures

the Court that the representation dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) shall be decided by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.

In view of the above, and without advertng to the merits of the case, the respondent No.2- Director Panchayat Haryana Panchayat Bhawan, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 30.03.2026 (Annexure P-2) after providing opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within seven days thereafter.

7. Petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
