**KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)**

1. Through the instant petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a direction upon the District Elementary Education Officer and Head Master (respondent no.4 and 5 respectively), to ensure that the admission of the petitioner in terms of the Right to Education Act, claiming entitlement thereunder.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No. 6-school is unnecessarily raising a dispute with regard to mismatch of the name of petitioner in the Aadhaar Card, as well as, the Birth Certificate.

3. On the last date of hearing vide order dated 12.05.2026, this Court had directed learned State counsel to have apposite instructions from the quarter concerned (i.e. District Elementary Education Officer), and thereupon, to inform, as to whether, the impediment cited by the authorities concerned, could be waived off, to grant admission to the petitioner in Government School (respondent no.6).

4. Pursuant to aforesaid direction, learned State counsel submits that the District Elementary Education Officer (respondent no.5), has ensured that respondent no.6-school, shall grant admission to the petitioner.

5. In view of the above, at this stage, the instant petition, is **disposed of** with a direction that, in case the petitioner through his natural guardian, approaches the District Elementary Education Officer (respondent no.5), the latter shall ensure that respondent No. 6-school shall grant admission to the petitioner.

6. After securing admission, the petitioner shall take necessary steps to get rectify the anomalies in the Aadhar Card as well as the Birth Certificate.

7. All pending application(s), if any, stand **disposed of** accordingly.
