MANDEEP PANNU, J. (Oral)

1. Petition under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (erstwhile Section 482 Cr.P.C.) seeking directions for registration of FIR against respondent Nos. 6 to 9 for alleged matrimonial fraud involving cheating, breach of trust, intimidation, and conspiracy, whereby about Rs. 34,00,000/- was allegedly taken from the petitioner and his family on the false promise of securing settlement in Canada, and further seeking a direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to decide the representation dated 20.03.2026 (Annexure P-3) in a time-bound manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the representation dated 20.03.2026 (Annexure P-3), within a time bound manner.

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4. On asking of the Court, Mr. Sahil Chowdhary, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents-State.

Without adverting to the merits of the case and in view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, Punjab, is directed to consider the representation dated 20.03.2026 (Annexure P-3) and decide the same within a period of one month.

6. The present petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
