1. Present petition has been filed praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus for appointing a warrant officer with a roving writ to search the detenue mentioned in Para No.2 of the petition at the premises of respondents No.4 to 6 or at any other place to be pointed out by the petitioner at the spot and get the detenue released with her belongings from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6 forthwith.

2. Petitioner is present in person before this Court.

3. On the asking of the Court, respondent-State has produced detenue, namely, Komal, before this Court.

4. The Court has interacted with the girl inside the Chamber. She has apprised the Court that she is 22 years of age and is pursuing her



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Masters in English. She has also stated that she is UPSC aspirant. She has fairly submitted before this Court that though she performed marriage with petitioner-Jagdeep Singh on 13.02.2026, however, the same was under the misguidance of the petitioner. She has stated that she has also verified the background of the petitioner and found that there are so many objectionable antecedents of the petitioner and thus, she does not want to continue with the marriage performed with the petitioner and she has filed the divorce petition, as well. She has stated that after the marriage, she voluntarily went to the house of her parents and presently she is happily living with them. She has stated that she wants to remain with her parents only.

5. In view of the submissions made, the present petition is disposed of. Detenue, namely, Komal, is at liberty to go with her parents as per her choice.
