Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the respondents to conclude the proceedings initiated against respondent No.6, Ex-Sarpanch of Gram Panchayat of village Mandheri, Block Ismailabad, District Kurukshetra, in a time bound manner.

2. Today, Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of the paper-book having already been supplied to her and informs the Court that the enquiry proceedings initiated against respondent No.6 already stand concluded and the complaint already stands closed by respondent No.5 i.e. learned Chief Vigilance Officer, Department of Development and Panchayats, Haryana. In this regard, she handed over a copy of letter dated 13.02.2026 in Court today, which is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Copy thereof has also been handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner



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submits that she may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy against the closure of complaint filed against respondent No.6 in accordance with law.
