KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. The main grievance which propelled the present petitioners to approach this Court by casting instant petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is the indolent and lackadaisical approach of the authority concerned, in not final deciding their legal notices dated 14.04.2026 (Annexure P-5).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners would be satisfied, in case a *mandamus* is passed upon



respondents, to take a final decision on their legal notices (*supra*), in a time bound manner.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that he has no objection, if the aforesaid direction is passed upon the respondent authorities.

4. In view of the above, and considering the prayer, as made by learned counsel for the petitioners, innocuous and *bona fide*, this Court, without observing anything on merits of the instant case, directs the respondent no.3, to take a final decision on the legal notices (*supra*), by passing a speaking order, within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. **Disposed of** accordingly.

A photocopy of this order be placed on the file of the connected case.
