1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to review/recall the posting orders dated 24.09.2024 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner and grant him opportunity to opt for new/nearby stations subject to available vacancies as of today as given to all the prior and subsequent batches except the batch of the petitioner in terms of their own consistent and long standing practice of station allotment by issuing a public notice and inviting station preferences based on seniority.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of his grievances, the petitioner has also submitted representation dated 24.04.2026 (Annexure P-9) before the respondents which is still pending consideration. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, if appropriate directions are issued to the respondents to consider and decide the said representation, by passing a speaking order, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

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4. Mr. Swapan Shorey, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 24.04.2026 (Annexure P-9) submitted by the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereon shall be conveyed to the petitioner.
