Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, against the respondent for willful disobedience of the directions issued by a Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.487 of 2024 vide order 09.12.2024.

2. Learned State counsel upon instructions from Sukhjinder Kaur, Superintendent, Director Industries & Commerce, Punjab contends that there were some objections having raised by the Accountant General Office, which would be removed by the Office of the respondent and the financial benefits would be released to the petitioner within a period of three weeks from today.

In that eventuality, the respondent shall be liable to pay costs of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only), to the petitioner.
