This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction to respondents No. 2 to 5 to restore the security cover of the petitioner with immediate effect as his life and liberty is in high danger and risk at the hands of unknown miscreants/Gangsters, in compliance of the orders dated 23.08.2025 and 22.01.2026 passed by this Court in CRWP-9336 of 2025 and CRWP-802-2026 (Annexures P-1 & P-2 respectively).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is the complainant in FIR No. 0293 dated 01.08.2025, registered against certain drug peddlers. It is submitted that in view of the threat perception faced by the petitioner, security cover had earlier been provided to him in compliance with the order dated 28.08.2025 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRWP-9336-2025. However, the said security cover has subsequently been

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withdrawn without assigning any reason. It is also submitted that the petitioner is facing threat perception at the hands of gangsters and therefore, prayer has been made for issuance of adequate directions to respondent No.3-Additional Director General of Police(Security), Punjab, to look into the matter and take immediate steps.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. P.S. Pandher, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material available on record.

6. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Additional Director General of Police (Security), Punjab to re-assess the threat perception of the petitioner in accordance with law and take an appropriate decision thereon within a period of four days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. It is also directed that in the event the petitioner submits an application for grant of an arms license, the competent authority shall consider and decide the same expeditiously in accordance with law.
