The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 to present the report under Section 173 of CrPC in a case arising out of FIR No.115 dated 08.07.2025, under Sections 406, 420 of Indian Penal code, Police Station Moti Nagar, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, against the respondent No.4.

2. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana to treat this petition as a representation of the petitioner and decide the same within the stipulated time.

4. Mr. Eklavya Darshi, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and waives service.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts and in the interest of justice, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to treat this petition as a representation of the petitioner and decide the same by passing a speaking order within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of instant order. It is however clarified that no finding is being returned, by this Court, with regard to merits of the contents of petition. The respondent No.2 shall be at liberty to make an independent assessment with regard to contents of the petition and take an independent decision at his own level.
