1. The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the BNSS seeking issuance of a direction to the Arresting Officer to release the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest in FIR No. 92 dated 22.03.2026, registered under Sections 75, 78, 79 and 351(3) of the BNS and Section 8 of the POCSO Act at Police Station Machhiwara, Khanna.

2. After completing his submissions, and when this Court was not inclined to grant the concession of anticipatory bail, learned counsel for the petitioner sought permission to withdraw the instant petition and has volunteered that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the trial Court within one week from today. He further prayed that a direction be issued to the trial Court that, in case the petitioner applies for regular bail, the same be decided expeditiously.



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3. Considering the above request and in light of the volunteered statement of the counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is ready to surrender, he may do so within one week from today and in case, the petitioner applies for regular bail thereafter, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously, preferably within 07 working days, on its own merits, in accordance with law and without being influenced by this order.

4. It is made clear that all the contentions raised by the petitioner shall remain open to be raised at an appropriate stage before the Court of competent jurisdiction.
