Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 18.12.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by the learned Divisional Commissioner, Karnal.

2. A perusal of the paper book would reveal that prayer made in the present writ petition is for setting aside the partition proceedings; however, neither the copy of the partition application nor the Mode of Partition, *Naksha 'Bey'*, *Naksha 'Zeem'* or *Sanad Takseem*, have been placed on record.



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3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh one with better particulars.

4. It is noticed that on an earlier occasion as well, the petitioner had filed the writ petition bearing CWP No.10929 of 2026, which was filed through the same counsel and was dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the petitioners to file fresh one with better particulars vide order dated 10.04.2026 (Annexure P-4); however, still there is no improvement in the present writ petition. The present writ petition has been filed in a very casual manner, which has resulted in wastage of the time of Court.

5. Keeping in view the above and in the interest of justice, one last opportunity is granted to learned counsel for the petitioner to file a better petition (complete in all respects); accordingly, the present writ petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to file fresh one on the same cause of action, with better particulars and after attaching all the relevant documents; however, subject to payment of costs of Rs.50,000/- to be deposited with ***“Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association Lawyers' Family Welfare Fund (Account No.41564846387, S.B.I. High Court Branch)”***.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
