Prayer in the instant writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside Mutation No.6388 dated 18.09.2025 (Annexure P-10) vide which, without any notice or hearing, Mutation No.1987 dated 27.05.1993 (Annexure P-3) has been illegally cancelled/changed from the name of Guru Nanak Dev Education Society to that of Gram Panchayat, Dehra and to restore Mutation No.1987 dated 27.05.1993 (Annexure P-3) as well as Mutation No. 2005 dated 20.10.1993 (Annexure P-4).

2. Learned Senior Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail remedy of appeal against the impugned Mutation No.6388 dated 18.09.2025 (Annexure P-10). He further submits that since no notice was issued to the petitioners before cancelling the aforesaid mutation No.6388 (Annexure P-10) and that the petitioners had



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directly approached this Court in the present writ petition; therefore, there would be some delay in filing the appeal; accordingly, prayer is made for issuance of appropriate directions for condonation of delay in filing the appeal before the learned Collector in terms of Section 13 of Haryana Land Revenue Act 1887 (in short '1887 Act').

3. Ms. Upasana Dhawan, AAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of the respondents-State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to her and submits that in case the petitioners file an appeal within a period of ten days from today, then the objection regarding limitation would not be taken.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to avail their remedy of appeal before the learned Collector in terms of Section 13 of 1887 Act.

4.1. It goes without saying that in case any such appeal is filed by the petitioner, within a period of ten days from today, the same shall be entertained by the concerned authority, without raising any objection as regards delay. It is further directed that the appeal, (if any), filed by the petitioner be considered and decided on its own merit after affording due opportunity of hearing to all the concerned parties.

5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
