1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to post the petitioner at Primary Health Centre Murthal Community Health Centre Juan, District Sonapat taking into account the fact that he is 100% physically handicap and in this regard certificate has been issued on 13.04.2022 (P-1) with further prayer to direct the respondents to release the 07 months educational allowance to the petitioner which has not been released till date as also to release the salary for the month of April, 2026 an annual increment accrued to him in January, 2026.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Ms. Mayuri Lakhanpal Kalia, DAG Haryana, having been served with an advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-



State and on instructions from the SMO, namely Dr. Gurmeet Singh, submits that the grievances raised by the petitioner with respect to non-release of salary for the month of April, 2026, the pending educational allowance for seven months, and the annual increment due from January, 2026, have already been duly considered by the competent authorities. It was further submitted that the necessary process for disbursement and release of the aforesaid dues shall be completed within a period of one week from the date of passing of the present order.

4. In view of the statement and assurance furnished on behalf of the respondent-State, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that he does not wish to press the present writ petition any further on the aforesaid monetary claims.

5. Consequently, in the backdrop of the aforesaid facts and submissions made before this Court, the present writ petition stands disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned State counsel. However, respondent No.1, namely the Additional Chief Secretary, Health Department, Haryana, and respondent No.2, namely the Director, Health Services, Haryana, are directed to sympathetically consider the petitioner's request regarding his posting/adjustment in light of his 100% physical disability and to pass a reasoned and speaking order in accordance with law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. It is further directed that the order so passed shall be duly communicated to the petitioner within one week thereafter.



6. It is, however, clarified that in the event any surviving grievance or subsisting cause of action remains unresolved, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail of his remedies in accordance with law, including approaching this Court afresh by way of appropriate proceedings.

7. All pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of accordingly.
