NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to consider and decide the petitioner's claim for re-allotment against a vacant station in a fair, transparent and non-discriminatory manner, particularly in view of letters dated 18.02.2026 and 06.05.2026 (Annexures P-11 and P-12), whereby the department reconsidered and granted readjustment to the similarly situated employees pursuant to the orders passed by this Court dated 05.03.2025, 20.11.2025 and 17.04.2026 (Annexures P-8 to P-10) and to decide the legal notice dated 10.02.2026 (Annexure P-6)
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for redressal of her grievances, the petitioner has also served legal notice dated



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10.02.2026 (Annexure P-6) to the respondents which is still pending consideration. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied, if appropriate directions are issued to the respondents to consider and decide the said legal notice, by passing a speaking order, in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Siddharth Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. He has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

6. Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide legal notice dated 10.02.2026 (Annexure P-6) submitted by the petitioner expeditiously, by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereon shall be conveyed to the petitioner.
