1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of communication dated 16.12.2024 whereby her claim for compensation under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Antyodaya Parivar Suraksha Yojna (for short '**Deen Dayal Yojna**') has been rejected.

2. As per petition, the petitioner's son passed away on 09.05.2024. He was 26 years old. His annual family income as per Parivar Pehchan Patra was less than ₹1,80,000. The petitioner filed an online application on 23.05.2024 seeking compensation under Deen Dayal Yojna. The respondent vide order dated 16.12.2024 has rejected her claim on the ground that there was discrepancy in his father's name in the death certificate vis-a-vis Family ID. The petitioner received the rectified Death Certificate on 04.03.2025. She could not re-apply due to the absence of provision on the online portal.

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She preferred representations dated 12.06.2025 and 15.11.2025 to the respondent seeking redressal of her grievance but the same has not been addressed till date.

3. Learned State counsel submits that if petitioner, as claimed, has already got amended particulars of her husband in Death Certificate vis-à-vis Family ID, the portal would be reopened if petitioner approaches respondent No.2-Chief Executive Officer, Haryana Parivar Suraksha Nyas, Panchkula, Haryana.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.

6. The petitioner shall appear before respondent No.2-Chief Executive Officer, Haryana Parivar Suraksha Nyas, Panchkula, Haryana on 19.05.2026 (Tuesday) at 11:00 AM
