KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition, cast under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a direction upon the respondents-university to get the petitioner's papers of written examination of 6th Semester held in May, 2021, re-evaluated. He also seeks for issuance of a direction to award Internal Assessment marks to him of 6th Semester Examination conducted in the year 2019. In alternative the petitioner seeks an opportunity to appear afresh in Internal Assessment Papers of 6th Semester conducted in the year 2023.

2. What transpires from a perusal of the instant petition, that till date the petitioner has not applied in a proper format seeking re-

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evaluation/rechecking of aforesaid papers, that too within the stipulated time period as per the university calender.

3. So far as second and third prayer are concerned, the respondent-university has come with a specific stand that the petitioner did not appear in the written examinations of 6th Semester examination in the May 2019. The petitioner was duly intimated through an e-mail on 07.07.2023 (Annexure R-1), that he can appear in the Sessional Exam of 3 hour duration at UIET, Kurukshetra, for 6th Semester of B.Tech., but the petitioner did not turn up, and has also not appeared till dated.

4. In the written statement as well, the respondents-university has taken a specific stand that the petitioner can appear in 6th Semester Sessional Exams of 3 hours duration, at UIET, Kurukshetra, if he so desires.

5. In view of the above the specific stand of the respondents-university, taken in the written statement filed way back on 30.07.2024, the petitioner till date, has not opted to appear before the respondents-university for the aforesaid exams.

6. Therefore, now considering the case of the petitioner, as a special case, liberty is given to the petitioner to cause appearance before the Registrar of the respondents-university within 15 days of the date of this order. Upon doing so, the latter shall fix the date of examination, and internal assessment/sessional exams, within 15 days thereafter, and thereupon, take a final decision.



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7. **Disposed of** accordingly.
8. All pending application(s), if any, also stand **disposed** of accordingly.
