NIDHI GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. By way of filing the present appeal the appellant-Insurance Company lays challenge to the impugned Award dated 04.01.2010, passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Nuh, in a claim petition bearing MACT Case No. 212 of 03.08.2009/14.02.2007, filed by respondent No. 1-claimant under Sections 140 and 160 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant-Insurance Company submits that the cross-appeal filed by respondent No. 1-claimant for enhancement bearing No. FAO-707-2011, titled as 'Azad @ Azad Mohammad vs. Kasir and others', has already been allowed by a co-ordinate Bench of his Court vide order dated 20.02.2023. It is accordingly, submitted that the present appeal has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of, as such.



3. A copy of order dated 20.02.2023, passed by the Predecessor Bench of this Court in FAO-707-2011, handed over in Court by learned counsel for the appellant is taken on record.
