1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ of certiorari for quashing the Notice dated 31.10.2020 (Annexure P-5), issued by respondent No.1, whereby the vacancies for the post of Multipurpose Health Worker (Female) has been reduced from 600 to 480, consequently reduce the vacancies of reserved category after completion of selection process. Further, seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents not to reduce the vacancies of Multipurpose Health Worker (Female) from 600 to 480.

2. On 21.03.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time for filing rejoinder. However, no rejoinder has been filed. There was no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last two consecutive dates of hearing. Even today also the position is the same. It appears that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petition.

3. In this view of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
