ALOK JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the alleged threat posed by the private respondents.

2. A perusal of the paper book reveals that there is no cogent material on record to substantiate any threat perception to the petitioners.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition, with liberty to file a fresh one on the basis of cogent material and a specific threat perception.

4. In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

5. However, it is needless to say that the State is duty-bound to protect the life and liberty of its citizens in accordance with law and hence, no further order is required to be passed.
