1. The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice dated 30.12.2025 (Annexure P-3).

3. On asking of the Court, Mr. Anmol Pratap Singh Mann, Additional Standing Counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that the legal notice dated 30.12.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner shall be decided within a period of three weeks.
