PANKAJ JAIN, J. (ORAL)

[1] On 29.04.2019, the following order was passed:-

“ Though a request for an adjournment has been made by learned counsel appearing for the appellants, Mr. Jain, learned counsel appearing for respondent no.3, has relied upon a judgment of the Supreme Court in United India Insurance Company Ltd. vs. Sujata Arora and others 2013 (3) ACC 918, to submit that where the driving licence of the driver of the vehicle was found to be fake, the insurance company is not liable to pay any compensation and therefore, the impugned Award does not require to be interfered with.

He further submits that with the appeal against the owner of the vehicle, i.e. respondent no. 2 herein, already having been dismissed on 23.09.2014, in any case the appeal against the insurance company and the driver alone would be purposeless.

For learned counsel for the appellants to distinguish the judgment cited by Mr. Jain, as also to address arguments, in terms of what he has contended with regard to the effect of dismissal of the appeal against the owner of the vehicle in issue, adjourned to 04.12.2019.”



[2] Thereafter, on 06.02.2024, the following order was passed:-

“ *Arguments heard in part.*

When faced with the situation that appeal against the owner of the vehicle i.e. respondent No.2 has already been dismissed, then how amount of compensation can be enhanced, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellants seeks some time to address arguments.

Adjourned to 08.04.2024.”

[3] Today, none has come present on behalf of the appellants.

[4] **Dismissed for non prosecution.**

[5] All pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, stands *disposed off.*
