SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, seeking regular bail in case FIR No. 151 dated 21.06.2024, under Sections 302, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act (Section 201 IPC has been added later on and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act were deleted), registered at Police Station Jandiala, Amritsar.

2. As per prosecution's case, accused-Sukhwinder Singh @ Kala entered into an agreement to sell with Gurdeep Singh (father of the complainant, Sawinder Singh @ Chhinda). In this regard, an earnest amount of ₹10 lakhs was received by accused-Sukhwinder Singh @ Kala. However, neither was the amount returned nor was the sale deed in respect of the plot executed. Instead, accused changed his mind and entered into a deal with some Bajwa Dairy owners on the pretext that the said amount of ₹10 lakhs would be paid by them.

When the parties assembled at the house of one Bhajan Singh for payment of the said amount, no settlement could be arrived at. Rather, it was decided that the Bajwa party would proceed to the plot, pay the amount to the complainant party, and thereafter take possession.

Petitioner-Shinder Singh, along with other accused persons, went to the spot. However, instead of returning the amount, two gunshots were fired by accused Kamaljeet Singh @ Gopi and Sandeep @ Sonu, resulting in the death of Harpreet Singh @ Lallo (brother of the complainant).

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with the observation that the statements of the eyewitness(s) be recorded in the first instance. Thereafter, it shall be open to the petitioner to file a fresh bail petition. Learned Trial Court is directed to carry out the said exercise expeditiously.

4. Let a copy of this order be forwarded to the concerned Trial Court for information and necessary compliance.
