ALOK JAIN, J. (Oral)

1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who have solemnized marriage against the wishes of their parents.

2. There are serious issues in the present petition, as no threat perception is coming forth except for the bald averments made in the petition. During the course of arguments, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioner No. 2 is presently working in a restaurant at Mohali, however, neither the particulars nor the address of the said place of

employment at Mohali have been disclosed in the petition. On the contrary the memo of parties reflects petitioner No. 2 to be a resident of Village Matta, District Faridkot, Punjab. Furthermore, no representation has been placed on record to show that the petitioners approached the authorities at Mohali for seeking protection. Apparently this fancy petition has been filed for seeking protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners without demonstrating any threat perception.

3. Faced with the above, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case.

5. Needless to say that the State is duty bound to protect the life and liberty of its citizens in accordance with law and hence, no further orders are required to be passed in that regard.
