1. The present petition has been filed for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing of impugned order dated 26.05.2026 (Annexure P-1) qua the petitioners passed by respondent No.2 vide which the petitioners have been selected for the promotion List-B for the year 2024, for which the Lower School Course has been scheduled to be held w.e.f. 07.06.2026 at HPA Madhuban, whereas, the petitioners have given their unwillingness to undergo the said course.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that identical matter i.e. **CWP-7040-2026** titled as **EHC Kaaraj Singh and others V/s State of Haryana and others** has already been decided on 10.03.2026 by

the Coordinate Bench, while relying upon the detailed judgment passed on 04.09.2025 in ***CWP-24483-2026*** titled as ***EHC Sandeep Kumar and others V/s State of Haryana and others.*** Learned counsel further prays for the identical relief whereby directions have been issued to the respondents to reconsider the case of the petitioners for the purpose of undergoing Lower School Course in List-B for the year 2024 in light of ***Sandeep Kumar's*** judgment (*supra*).

3. At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the judgment passed in the ***Sandeep Kumar's*** case (*supra*) has been assailed by the State in LPA-122-2026 and the same is now fixed for **31.08.2026**.

4. Heard learned counsel for the parties.

5. It is very strange that on one hand the petitioners want to remain in the service but on the other hand are unwilling to improve their caliber to serve the State, although the said issue is already *res integra* in the aforesaid LPA but admittedly there is no stay against the orders passed in **CWP-7040-2026**.

4. In light of the above, the present petition is also disposed of in the same terms as in **CWP-7040-2026**.
