1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and also direct the respondents No.4 to 7 not to interfere in her life and liberty.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 03.06.2026 (Annexure P-2) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala and she shall be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into her aforesaid representation.

3. Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without expressing anything on the merits and claim of the parties, respondent No.2- the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, is directed to depute a senior officer to look into the matter and after seeking a report, he may pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law.
7. The parties mentioned in the petition or any other person mentioned in the petition shall be at liberty to take recourse to appropriate law, if any.
8. With these observations, this petition is disposed of.
