1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner which is in danger at the hands of private respondents No.4 to 7.

2. The brief facts of the case are that respondent No.7 applied for license for a revolver, however, the petitioner filed an objection before the competent authority against the grant of said arms license. As such, the respondent No.7 became agitated with the petitioner. As per the petitioner, respondent No.7 has openly brandished a revolver at the petitioner on multiple occasions. Taking into consideration the abovesaid fact, the petitioner filed a representation dated 01.06.2026 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if at this stage, direction is given to

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respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 01.06.2026 (Annexure P-1) submitted by petitioner in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amarpreet Singh Bains, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated 01.06.2026 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law/rules, within a period of 02 weeks from today.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
