The two petitioners are residing in live-in-relationship. Petitioner No.1 is married and having minor son; whereas petitioner No.2 is unmarried.

It is submitted that petitioner No.1 has already filed divorce petition against his wife (Annexure P-4). Alleging that father and brother of petitioner No.2 i.e. respondent Nos.4 and 5 are threatening the life and liberty of the petitioners, the petitioners have now sought necessary protection through respondent Nos.1 to 3.

Notice of motion to respondent Nos.1 to 3 only.

Mr. Karanveer Singh, Senior DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3- State.

Learned State counsel submits that on getting the representation from the petitioners, statement of respondent Nos.4 and 5



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were recorded and both of them have stated that they will not cause any harm to the petitioners and that they have no objection with relationship of the petitioners.

In view of the aforesaid statement made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners submit that petition may be disposed of.

In view of above, there appears to be no longer any threat perception to life and liberty of petitioner and so, there is no need to pass any order for grant of protection.
