1. This petition, which has been categorized as PIL, raises concerns of resident of Chandigarh as regards lack of maintenance of Rose Garden in Sector 16, which is the responsibility of Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh. The aforesaid concern was raised after holding of Rose Festival in February, 2017.



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2. Learned counsel for respondents No. 2 and 3 – Municipal Corporation has filed its reply stating that Rose Garden was restored to its original beauty and cleanliness in February, 2017 itself.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand of Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh, and the assurance that the Rose Garden, which is one of the iconic green patches in the city of Chandigarh, shall be maintained in future, this Court declines to continue with this petition and disposes of the same.
