This first petition has been filed under Section 483 read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of interim bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.185 dated 10.07.2025, under Section(s) 103(1) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 27(3) of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sector 56, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that son of the



petitioner had passed away on 09.06.2026 due to sudden cardiac arrest. He submits that since ritual of rasam pagri is to be performed on 22.06.2026 and the petitioner being father is required to perform said ritual, he be granted interim bail for a period of 15 days till 27.06.2026.

Status report on behalf of respondent-State has been filed in the Court today. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

State counsel does not dispute the factum of death of son of the petitioner and submits that as per the status report, rasam pagri rituals are to be performed on 22.06.2026.

Accordingly, the petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of 03 days commencing w.e.f. 21.06.2026 to 23.06.2026. He shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the concerned Jail authorities on 23.06.2026 before 4:00 P.M.

The application stands disposed of accordingly.
