The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.85 dated 04.05.2026 registered under Sections 420, 120-B Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar, District Patiala.
