By way of this petition filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, petitioner prays for issuance of the appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of private respondent, who is declared proclaimed person in NACT-357-2023 "Nasir Ali vs. Wasim Akram".

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that on the complaint filed by the petitioner, proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act were initiated against respondent No.4. The said respondent No.4 was declared proclaimed person in those proceedings and now the said respondent No.4 is pressurizing the petitioner to withdraw the complaint. Petitioner made a representation (Annexure P-1) to Senior Superintendent of Police, District Malerkotla, but no action has been taken so far.
