Petitioner prays for his release on emergency parole under Section 5 of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 in case FIR No.112 dated 06.05.2022 registered under Sections 120-B, 186, 201, 307, 333, 379 and 411 of the IPC, 1860 read with Section 34 of IPC [corresponding Sections 61, 221, 238, 109, 121(2), 303(2) and 317(2) of BNS, 2023] and Sections 25, 27 and 29(b) of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar so as to enable him to attend the bhog ceremony of his grandfather namely Ranjit Singh, which is stated to be fixed for 21.06.2026 as his grandfather had expired on 12.06.2026.

It is noticed by this Court that though the grandfather of the petitioner is stated to have expired on 12.06.2026 but the petition has been filed in such a way that there is no time left for this Court to seek verification from the police because 20.06.2026 and 21.06.2026 are holidays being Saturday and Sunday.



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In the aforesaid circumstances, there is no justification to release the petitioner on emergency parole.
