1. In the present writ petition, the petitioner has challenged the order dated 06.04.2021 (Annexure P-15) passed by respondent No.4, whereby, adverse remarks have been recorded for the period from 01.04.2020 to 23.09.2020.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the abovesaid ACR has been recorded on the basis of departmental proceedings initiated against the petitioner and on the basis of abovesaid departmental proceedings, the respondents have also passed an order dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-20), vide which, 03 future annual increments of the petitioner has been stopped with permanent effect. He submits that against the adverse remarks recorded for the period 01.04.2020 to 23.09.2020, the petitioner had submitted a representation which was dismissed by the competent authority. He further submits that aggrieved against the order dated 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-20), the petitioner had filed an appeal before

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the competent authority and the same was dismissed vide order dated 29.07.2021 (Annexure P-23). Learned counsel submits that aggrieved against the order dated 29.07.2021 (Annexure P-23), the petitioner has filed a revision petition before respondent No.2, which is still pending. He, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if at this stage, direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the revision petition dated 05.08.2021 (Annexure P-24) filed by the petitioner before respondent No.2, which is still pending, in a time-bound manner.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents-State does not oppose the prayer made by the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner.

4. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the revision petition dated 05.08.2021 (Annexure P-24) filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law/rules, within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of.
