1. Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, for directing the respondents No.2 and 3 – Passport Authorities to decide petitioner's representation dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P-6) and to take all necessary steps to ensure that correct date of birth of petitioner is reflected in the passport.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents – Passport Authorities submits that present petition has been rendered infructuous as the passport of the petitioner already stands issued.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by the learned counsel for the respondents – Passport Authorities, the instant writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

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3.1 However, in case, if any of the grievance of petitioner still remains unaddressed, then petitioner is at liberty to seek revival of the petition, in accordance with law.
