By way of this petition filed under Sections 10 / 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, petitioner prays for initiation of contempt proceedings for non-compliance of the order dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-3) passed by this Court in CRWP-6471-2026 titled *Lila Devi vs. State of Haryana and others*.

2. The operative portion of the order dated 29.05.2026 is as under:-

"5. In view the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 13.05.2026 (Annexure P-7) of the petitioner qua threat perception only within a period of 30 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law."

3. Notice of motion.

4. Sh. Tarun Aggarwal, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-3), a speaking order dated 24.06.2026 has already been passed. Learned State counsel has also placed on record a



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copy of the said speaking order. A copy of the order has been supplied to counsel for the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel submits that he will challenge the order dated 24.06.2026.

6. Since, the order dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-3) has already been complied by the respondent, therefore, the present contempt petition stands disposed of. However, the petitioner will be at liberty to challenge the order dated 24.06.2026 in case, he wishes so or to avail any other remedy which is available to him in accordance with law.
