MANISHA BATRA, J (ORAL):-

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226/227 of the constitution of India read with Section 5 of the Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022 seeking issuance of directions to official respondents to adjudicate upon the emergency parole application of the petitioner dated 18.06.2026 (Annexure P-1)

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a representation on 18.06.2026 (Annexure P-1) before respondent No.4-Superintendent of Jail, District Jail, Karnal, raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.4 Superintendent of Jail,



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Karnal, to decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Apoorv Garg, Addl. A.G, Haryana, has advance notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to him during the course of the day.

In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondent No. 4- Superintendent of Jail, Karnal to decide the aforesaid representation dated 18.06.2026 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of 20 days from today, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.
