In case, it is found that the claim raised is admissible, the same will be granted otherwise, due reasons for not accepting the claim of the petitioners will be mentioned in the speaking order so passed, which order will be conveyed to the petitioners for their information and necessary action.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
