1. The petitioners have filed the instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and their family members. A further prayer was made to direct the official respondents not to harass the petitioners and their other family members.

2. Mr. Amit Rana, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is on advance notice, on instructions from SHO Police Station Sadar Kharar, submits that certain complaints were received from both the sides, however, the same pertain to civil dispute between the parties and all the complaints have been ordered to be consigned to record.

3. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required to be passed and the petition is accordingly dismissed.
