This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking for writ in the nature of mandamus.

2. It has been prayed by the petitioner that a direction be issued to the respondent No.2 to decide his application dated 29.05.2026 (Annexure P-2), for grant of regular parole for a period of ten weeks, within the stipulated time.

3. **Notice of motion.**

4. Mr. Ramender Singh Chauhan, AAG Haryana appears on behalf of respondent-State. Hence service of notice upon the State is hereby dispensed with.



5. Heard.

Since the period of disposal of application seeking for regular parole for a period of ten weeks, has been stipulated in the provisions of 'Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2022' and as per allegation of the petitioner, despite the lapse of abovementioned timeline, the respondents No.2 to 4 have not taken any decision on the application of the petitioner, the present petition is hereby ***disposed of*** with a direction to the respondents No.2 to 4 to take a decision on the representation/application filed by the petitioner seeking for regular parole for a period of ten weeks, within a period of ten days, from the date of receipt of copy of this order and communicate the same to the petitioner, in writing.

7. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
